

INTRODUCTION

The Association of Chinese Scientists and Engineers – USA (ACSE) (http://www.acse.org) is one of the largest Chinese-American professional associations in the United States. Founded in 1992, the ACSE is an independent, non-political, not-for-profit professional organization headquartered in Chicago with regional chapters in fifteen states. Consisting of twelve professional societies, including Telecommunications, Chemistry & Chemical Engineering, Pharmaceutics, Mechanical Engineering, Management Business and Administration, Futures, Options and Finance, Medical Sciences, Computer Sciences, Industrial and Applied Mathematics, Environment, Bio-technology, Intelligent Transportation Systems, and Law. More than 2500 members come from 30 states of USA. Over 50 percent of the members have Ph.D. degree and 40 percent of them hold Master degree.

With its principle of "Cooperate, Develop and Contribute", ACSE has carried out many major events in the United States and China to build up network and bridge USA and China in many areas, such as sciences, technology, culture, economics and business. These activities include the spring conferences, annual convention, exchange delegations of science and technology between USA and China, job fairs, seminars on education, career development, investment, insurance, immigration, using law to protect yourself and family, culture differences between USA and China, US companies in China, entertainment activities etc., in order to serve ACSE members and communities. In the past events organized and sponsored by ACSE, many prominent leaders of industry, science, business and government were invited and attended the activities. 旅美中国科学家工程师专业人士协会(简称科工专协会,万维网址:http://www.acse.org)是由在美国的企业、大学、国家实验室、研究机构工作和从事专业服务的中国学人组成的非政治性,非盈利的专业团体,于1992年四月在芝加哥成立,在伊利诺州正式注册,享有美国联邦政府的免税资格。科工专协会成立以来,迅速发展,已发展累計到2500多名在册会员,分布在全美二十多个州,百分之九十以上的协会会员具有硕士、博士学位。协会总部设在芝加哥,十五地方分会遍及从纽约到洛杉矶的全美各地。所属十二个专业分会涵盖了电子、信息、软件,生物、材料、机械、医学、医药、化学和化工,能源和环保等各科技产业门类和金融、法律、企业管理领域。科工专协会已经成为在美国最大,最有影响力的华人专业组织之一。协会名誉顾问包括人大常委会副委员长吴阶平,人大常委会副委员长、前中国科学院院长周光召,国务委员、中国工程院院长、前国家科委主任宋健,前美国总统科学顾问、前加州大学伯克利分校校长田长霖和美国首任驻中华人民共和国大使伍德科克等。

Dear distinguished guests, our speakers, ACSE members, Ladies and Gentlemen,

First I would like to welcome everyone to the ACSE's 16th annual conference. Thanks to our honored guests and great speakers. Your attendance and contribution will make this conference a great success.

Motivated by spiraling fuel cost, growing concerns about ozone, and surging consumer demand for green products, the Association of Chinese-American Scientists and Engineers is hosting its conference to discuss the opportunity, responsibility as well as challenge in developing sustainable resources and to build eco-friendly communities. Organic product, sustainable agriculture, recycling, reducing carbon emission, and conservation of energy resonate with public who care about their healthy green living, and impact on environment and nature resources. 2008 Beijing Olympic projects have employed many energy conservation technologies ranging from electric vehicle, solar power, to rain water reutilization. The 29th Olympic was applauded as a green Olympic.

Let me also take this opportunity to express my great gratitude to the ACSE leaders (past and present), volunteers and all our members. It is your dedication and contribution that made this organization one of the largest, influential Chinese-American communities across the States. There are many, many unknown heroes, dedicated volunteers who sacrifice their family time and devote their greatest effort to help out ACSE. These are valuable assets of ACSE. Rather than mentioning few names with limited time and space, I decided not to list any. But my sincere thanks go to everyone who volunteered. It is your dedication that makes ACSE successful.

Looking back for the past year, ACSE has achieved its principal goal in building the exchange platforms for Chinese and American for all levels, from state, enterprise to individuals. ACSE hosted two government delegations from Shanxi province government, Shanghai GuoQiaoBan led by Zhou Hong and Jiangsu Province Science and Technology Division led by Yang Yu. The Shanxi State delegation was led by the deputy vice governor, Zhao Zhengyong. This is the visit followed by the ACSE's visitto Shanxi province in order to further strength the corporation between ACSE and Shanxi province.

Nine industrial business leaders from Wuxi city, Jiangsu province, just visited Chicago three weeks ago. This group consists of Liu Yuhai, CEO of Wuxi Industrial Development Groups, and Du Yi, General Manager of Wuxi BeiChuang Science and Technology Innovation Park. ACSE hosted a business discussion forum with Wuxi delegation. There were about 40 ACSE members attended the forum. During the meeting, ACSE and Wuxi Beichuang Park has signed a general corporation agreement. ACSE will provide a communication and exchange platform for Wuxi to promote their products, and to bridge Wuxi with American companies. With ACSE's introduction, Wuxi delegation also met with industrial companies for face to face direct talks. Corporation with Wuxi is a starting point, and ACSE is engaging with many similar entities.

ASCE has its delegation to visit China and met with number of government and industrial leaders. Our goal is to promote exchange and corporation. ACSE was invited as the overseas scholars to tour in China, and met with the Chinese Youth Leader, Secretary He Junke. During the Zhongguancun technology park's visit, ACSE connected once again with the Beijing city top leader Zhu Shanlu and the park General Manager Xia Yingqi. The annual Guanzhou Exchange Forum has attracted ACSE for years, and we had our presence this year as well. Another big event ACSE attended is the gathering of three States in the Changjiang triangle development zone.

ACSE has made a concrete steps in corporation with local companies and business. ACSE has developed relationship to work with our key sponsors, such as Motorola, Prudential and BP. ACSE will continue to bring potential business delegations and governmental delegations to our sponsors for a direct communication and exchange.

ACSE's traditional and cultural activities attract many members. They provide the opportunities for culture inheritance and networking. ACSE has reached out to Alumni associations. We teamed up with them to host the Chinese New Year party and the summer picnic. There were nearly 300 attended the Chinese Spring Festival Dinner and more than 700 the summer picnic. The summer picnic event is one of the largest in the greater Chicago area with many sponsors, including Motorola. Another big event organized by ACSE is the NBA game going in Milwaukee, WI. Two NBA stars, Yao Ming and Yi Jianlian both from China, will meet the first time ever to play against each other. Many ACSE members are super fans of Yao and Yi, and this is the historical game that they do not want to miss. About 300 fans went to the game, and the Chinese Central Television (CCTV) interviewed ACSE.

Nature holds the greatest power, but sometimes it is devastating. There were two big natural disasters hit China in 2008. The southern freezing rain and snow storm came in the time millions of Chinese were on their way home to celebrate the traditional Chinese New Year. Trains were blocked in the middle of nowhere, and power lines were collapsed. ACSE members stand up and donated money (\$1128.00) to help people to get home for their traditional holiday gathering. In May 21, a powerful earthquake waked up the world. Thousands of lives were buried and thousands of homes were destroyed. Road was broken, power was out and communication system was down. In these disastrous situations, ACSE members showed a great humanity. Quickly over \$24,000.00 was donated from all members. ACSE is part of the greater Chicago communities to establish one middle school to be name "四川彭州芝加哥侨爱中学"and one primary school to be named "四川青洲芝加哥侨爱中学" in Sichuan.

ACSE has always helped our members to enhance their skills in career development, leadership and even finding a job. Our career development seminar has attracted more than 200 members. Both Motorola and Prudential had their teams to discuss the career development, diversity and opportunity. Career enhancement and leadership development are ACSE's continuing education topics to benefit our members. During our conference today, the Motorola leaders will bring us great educational and convincing presentations and discussions about this topic. I am looking forward for that.

ASCE has grown tremendously during the last few months. The Society of Environmental Scholars and Professionals has jointed ACSE as ACSE Environmental Society. It brings more than 1000 members. On behalf of ACSE, I welcome our Environmental Society.

Looking forward into the coming year, ACSE will strength its position in building platforms for technology and culture exchanges. With our bilateral connections, ACSE continues to work with current partners in the US and China, and reach out to new potential companies. ACSE will bring the Chinese enterprises to the United States and talk to each other directly. This will benefit companies and people in both countries.

For our members, ACSE continues its effort to provide educational and informational seminars and discussions. The cultural and traditional activities have given our members the opportunities to meet with old friends and make new friends, and to remind us the unique cultural history. Our members will be informed first with any opportunities such as business and job openings.

2008 is an election year. Americans will make their decisions about their future this year. We are Americans and we are Chinese Americans. Many of us express great concerns about the family value and education. It will be your choice and your responsibility to exercise your right. I am taking this opportunity to urge all our eligible members to cast your vote on November 4.

Everyone feels the pain at gas pumps. The crisis of destabilized climate change and rising competition for energy could poison our world of living. ACSE, as a community, has to play a role in social responsibility and sustainable green effort. Green is a big word with many areas covered. Many of our members are in the frontier of inventing and developing new energy sources and new technologies. 欣闻贵会举行以"绿色奥运与绿色资源的可持续发展"为主题的2008年会,特此表示祝贺!发展绿色能源代表着世界能源生产与消费的新趋势,对于减少环境污染、保护自然资源、应对全球气候变化、实现人类社会的可持续发展将发挥巨大的作用。贵会选择"绿色资源"作为今年年会的主题,意义重大。

中国能源生产与消费总量巨大。2006年,中国一次能源生产总量为22.1亿吨标准煤,列世界第二位。其中,原煤产量23.7亿吨,列世界第一位;原油产量1.85亿吨,列世界第五位;天然气产量586亿立方米;电力装机容量和发电量分别达到6.22亿千瓦和2.87万亿千瓦时,均列世界第二位。2006年,中国一次能源消费总量为24.6亿吨标准煤,其中煤炭的比重高达69.4%,而可再生能源和核电比重只有7.2%。今后若干年,中国的能源生产与需求将继续保持强劲的增长势头。

绿色能源的发展在中国方兴未艾。发展绿色能源能够缓解中国工业化进程中的能源紧张和环境问题,降低中国对矿物燃料尤其是石油的需求,进一步提高中国的能源安全。中国政府发布的《可再生能源中长期发展规划》提出,中国到2010年和2020年将使可再生能源消费量分别达到能源消费总量的10%和15%2007年中国的绿色能源项目投资达60亿英镑,居全球第二,仅略低于全球投资最高的德国。今年中国宣布对绿色能源的投入将在去年的基础上再增加一倍。预计今后二三十年,中国每年可供开发利用的绿色能源可达8亿吨标准煤。因此可以预料,绿色能源相关的技术、设备和项目在中国将有着广泛的需求和广阔的市场。

贵会是旅美各领域科技专业人士组成的重要团体,多年来奉行"合作、发展、贡献"的创会宗旨,关心祖国发展,充分发挥自身优势,在推动中美科技、文化交流和友好合作方面发挥了积极而重要的作用。

Angie Tang is Regional Representative of the **US Department of Labor**, appointed by President George W. Bush in October 2001. Ms. Tang is Labor Secretary Elaine Chao's spokesperson and intergovernmental liaison in Region II which includes New York, New Jersey, Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands.

Prior to joining the U.S. Department of Labor, Ms. Tang was Senior Advisor at Emergent Capital, a venture capital firm in New York. She was executive director of New York City Mayor's Office of Immigrant Affairs and Language Services. As a cabinet official under the administration of Mayor Rudolph W. Giuliani, Ms. Tang developed and implemented effective initiatives including the creation of a cost-saving naturalization assistance program, Citizenship NYC. She is published on the subject of global migration and its impact on receiving countries. Her publications include "A Sensible Immigrant Policy in New York City" (University of British Columbia, Vancouver) and "Immigrants and the Economic Revitalization of New York City" (St. John's University, New York.)

Dr. Nancy Ho One of the Sixty World's Greatest Minds

Dr. Nancy Ho is currently a research professor in the School of Chemical Engineering at Purdue University. She received her Ph.D. degree from the Department of Biological Sciences in Purdue University. She then joined the same university as a scientist in DNA research fields. In1980, she was invited to join the Laboratory of Renewable Resources Engineer (LORRE) to establish its Molecular Genetics Group. Since then, Dr. Ho has focused her efforts on using recombinant DNA techniques to improve industrial microorganisms. Her most well known work is the development of recombinant yeast that can effectively produce ethanol from all types of cellulosic plant materials – such as corn stalks, wheat straws, wood, and grasses. So far, one company has successfully produced ethanol in large quantity from wheat straw using her Ho-Purdue yeast since 2004. Quite a few other companies are in the process of producing ethanol from various types of cellulosic biomass using the same yeast.

Dr. Ho has received numerous honors for her development of the cellulosic ethanol-producing yeast. Those include the R&D 100 award in 1998, the Discover Magazine award in 2000. She was also named by Indiana Senator Lugar as his September 2006 Energy Patriot, and recognized by the President of the United States, Mr. George Bush who invited her as one of his guests attending the State of the Union Address on January 23, 2007. Recently, Dr. Ho was among the 60 of the world's leading scientists, writers, artists, business and civic leaders whose essay were published in a new book edited by veteran TV journalist Mike Wallace – "The Way Will be 50 Years from Today: 60 of the World's Greatest Minds Share Their Visions of the Next Half-Century".

Dr. Ho is not only a top scientist, but also an excellent entrepreneur. She believes that she can contribute more to the growth of cellulosic ethanol industry in this country and around the world by establishing a unique company. As such she founded Green Tech America, Inc. (www.greentechamerica.com) in 2006 to facilitate cellulosic ethanol production throughout the world.
